- e) Not engage in activities that diversely affect the quality of his/her teaching.
- f) Not teach under the influence of alcohol or drugs and shall not come to school while intoxicated.
- g) Not criticize other teacher in the hearing of learner.
- h) Not sexually molest, harass or have sexual relationship with learners or fellow work mates.
- i) Follow the program that is approved by the head of department and shall cooperate with the head of department.
- j) Devote adequate time to his/her duties as is required by the nature of his/her profession.
- k) Not be an accomplice to any activity likely or intended to cause riot within the school.
- l) Maintain and keep in safe manner all records of the school property under his/her care and account for such property when asked to account by the head of department, DOS or head of school.
- m) Dress appropriately, decently and smartly while on duty but not too much decoration.
- n) Take punctuality as an ingrained habit to avoid discontinued.
- o) Not be allowed to fight either with a learner, staff member and community member and never lose temper in public.
- p) Not be involved in any corrupt activities or embezzlement of funds from parents, learners or school.
- q) Not coach pupils in any way within the school, all pupils are to be taught equally.

## PUPIL'S SCHOOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- a) All learners must obey school authorities including among others the head Teacher, Deputy, Teachers, Visitors and the support staff.
- b) No pupil is allowed outside the school without permission from either Head teacher, DOS, T.O.D or any teacher around.

- h) Loitering on the compound, being rowdy, noisy or any other distractive behavior during preps and other times are completely unacceptable.
- i) No outsiders may be invited to the school to address or interact—with pupils without prior permission from the Administration.
- j) Theft of any kind is not allowed in the school and if one found, his/her studies will be terminated.
- k) Spreading of rumors is prohibited and shall be treated seriously.
- l) Bullying of any form including teasing of pupils by fellow pupils is strictly forbidden.
- m) Fighting is strictly prohibited in school.
- n) Dormitories are out of bounds to all pupils during classes.
